

Background

Bonga Na Gava Is a tool set for youth and communities to present their voice in conversations of government policy, laws & regulations. Bonga Na Gava Warriors are a set of youth selected by merit to give first hand thoughts, recommendations and opinions on proposed government policies, laws & regulations, which ultimately create the Bonga Na Gava top line comments. We ensure that our top line comments are in line with the vision, mission and values that SUSO stands for..

Bonga Na Gava Warriors Platform with 85 youth (to date) serves as a platform to prepare young people for roles in conservation and leadership. They will become our ambassadors, sharing opportunities to engage in submitting comments on proposed government policies, laws, and regulations. Additionally, they will play a crucial role in educating others on how to utilise the website as a tool for submitting comments.

Through the BNG warriors platform we aim to establish a safe space where youth can engage in discussions about critical issues related to biodiversity, climate change and the environment. Here they will learn how to effectively use their voices to drive change and advocate for the implementation of relevant policies, laws and regulations.

The platform will serve as an educational space where we will inform youth and communities about the significance of public participation. It will provide them with opportunities to engage in physical public participation activities and learn about the process of formulating government policies, laws and regulations

Introduction

The BNG Warriors Training Workshop is a one-day intensive program designed to enhance the capacity of current members of the platform. The workshop focuses on creating a sense of community among the warriors, equipping them with advanced advocacy skills and the use of the BNG Platform (Website, WhatsApp & Instagram) as effective spaces for policy & advocacy.

Aim

To empower BNG Warriors with the skills, knowledge, and resources needed to actively and effectively engage in public participation and leadership using the BNG Warriors platform.

Objectives

1. Co-create a unified vision for the BNG Warriors 2025 initiative.
2. Establish functional working groups with clear roles, Terms of Reference (TORs), and actionable work plans.

Pillars of the Workshop

- **Vision and Purpose:** Co-creating a shared vision for the BNG Warriors' mission and goals.
- **Capacity Building:** Equipping participants with knowledge, tools, and frameworks to effectively carry out BNG Warriors' initiatives.
- **Strategic Planning:** Developing detailed work plans aligned with the BNG Warriors' goals for 2025.
